

Dear Friends in Christ,

If you're reading this, then you know that the world did not end on December 21, 2012 as some say the Mayans predicted. Nor did the world end on October 21, 2011 (or September 6, 1994) as predicted by Harold Camping. Nor did the world end as the Jehovah's Witnesses predicted in 1914 (1925, 1931, 1941, 1966, 1975 and 1994).

In fact, all predictions about the exact date for the end of the world have not come to pass. Yet each year many people claim to know the date, claim to know when the Last Day will happen. Because of the prominence of the Mayan 12/21 date, I thought it would be wise for us to take a brief look at what the Bible actually says.

First, the world will end. Rejoice! For this is *good news*. It's good news that the world is going to end. Scripture teaches that the ground is cursed because of our sin, and that it groans in anticipation of the Last Day. For on that day, God will destroy the earth and **recreate** it. It will be a perfect world; there will be no more curse, no more weeds or thistles.

Second, on that day the dead will be raise from their graves. And if we are still alive on that day, we shall be changed in the twinkling of an eye. Our bodies, which are falling apart due to the corruption we suffer in a sinful world, will be transformed into imperishable bodies. This, too, is *good news*. In this new era, we won't need glasses or medicines or canes, because our bodies will be perfect. Even better, we won't have the desire to sin anymore. The temptations that we face in this life will be gone forever.

So when will this happen? Well, frankly it could happen at anytime. It could happen before you receive this article, or moments after you read it. It is important to remember that we are already living in the last days. (Hebrews 1:2). Jesus' birth began the Day of the Lord. That's one of the reasons we celebrate Christmas, because His coming brought healing and forgiveness.

Now we wait, we wait for the final coming of our Lord and Savior. We wait for the Day of Judgment. "Concerning that day and hour," Jesus says, "no one knows, not even the angels of heaven, nor the Son, but the Father only." (Mat 24:36 ESV) But for the believer, it's not a day to fear. God has already pronounced judgment on us, "there is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. For the law of the Spirit of life has set you free in Christ Jesus from the law of sin and death." (Rom 8:1-2 ESV) The verdict is known; we have been declared not guilty in Jesus Christ.

It's the end of the world, no. It's the beginning of something new and better; something that we can barely imagine or comprehend. So let's rejoice and celebrate.


Thank You!
