Meet Robert...

Robert works on the International side of the ministry.

Robert is spending the week with us at the Atlanta Processing Center serving as a Table Coach. He shared how incredible it has been to join us and experience all we do on this side of the shoebox to make the other side of the shoebox possible! He truly appreciates all of the volunteers who work so hard. He thanks God for our shoebox packers and processors...and their heart for the ministry.

He shared with us 1 Peter 2:9

"But you are not like that, for you are a chosen people. You are royal priests, a holy nation, God's very own possession. As a result, you can show others the goodness of God, for he called you out of the darkness into his wonderful light."

He focused on the fact that we are CHOSEN ..and because we are Chosen and called out of darkness into light, we are called to share with others who then can come out of darkness into God's wonderful light! We can do that through Operation Christmas Child.

He wanted to share about one of the most spiritually darkest areas. There are 1.2 BILLION people who have NOT HEARD ABOUT JESUS! That's 1.2 BILLION LOST SOULS! It is the GREATEST CONCENTRATION OF LOSTNESS ON EARTH!

He shared an impact story that happened in one of the most remote villages in that region with an Unreached People Group (UPG) . The people are very poor, they live in mud huts, and have no running water. They have for generations practiced worshipping false gods, they are steeped in witchcraft and fortune telling, and demon possession is very common. They are violently opposed to outsiders. They often hurt any outsiders that try to come into their village.

A local Pastor has a church not far from this people group and he has been very burdened to tell them about Jesus. He has tried many times to get into the village to talk with them but he has always been denied. This local Pastor heard about Operation Christmas Child and became one of our Ministry Partners. It was OCC shoeboxes that opened the way for the Pastor to get into the village !

The Pastor got permission for the outreach and the day he went to the village He was nervous how he would be received since they have hurt others when they tried. Incredibly, He was greeted by every single person that lived in the village. They had set up a tent, had their instruments playing and welcomed Him with open arms. There were 140 children and they all heard the Gospel! Then they asked the children if they'd like to go through The Greatest Journey....people who up to that point had never heard the name of Jesus...and 80 children showed up for Discipleship Class. PRAISE THE LORD!

There was one little boy who never had a pair of shoes in his whole life! When he received His shoebox, to his surprise he received a brand new pair of sneakers...that fit him perfectly! His parents proclaimed for days how they were just the right size! He wore them everywhere showing them off . They couldn't understand why someone who didn't know them would send them such an amazing gift. The Pastor shared how this was a tangible expression of God's LOVE! God gave His only Son to die for us so we could have the free gift of salvation and eternal life with Jesus. The Pastor asked them to come to church, people who practiced witchcraft and they accepted his invitation and the Pastor is now building a relationship with them .

Join us as we pray for this People Group...and the many other doors that the Shoeboxes are opening up to share and proclaim the name of Jesus. Pray that the generational darkness in these communities will experience JESUS' WONDERFUL LIGHT!
