Liz Shuttleworth preschool@ princeofpeacefreedom.com forbids us to take the life of another person (murder, abortion, euthanasia) or our own life (suicide). And the unborn are a living person in the sight of God from the time of conception. Since abortion takes a human life, it isn't a moral option except to prevent the death of another person, the mother.

The United States Supreme Court's ruling on Friday, June 24th of this year did not end abortion in America, The Supreme Court correctly ruled that abortion should be a matter for each individual state to decide. People on the political "Left" claim that abortion is a fundamental Constitutional right. No where within the framework of the Constitution is anyone given the right to murder an unborn child. And so it is not a Constitutional right. We have a Constitutional right of life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness, which is contradictory to abortion that takes away these fundamental rights from the unborn.
